



Rick Muncrief is the Chairman and CEO of WPX Energy (NYSE:WPX) based in Tulsa. Since coming to WPX, Rick has overseen \$8 billion of transactions that radically changed the company's portfolio, most notably its 2015 entry into the Permian Basin.
